What is the "White Sands Community Hall Society"?

The Hall Society is a "volunteer" run non-profit organization registered under the Societies Act of the Alberta Corporate Registry. It was formed to manage the funds earned from the donation of cans/bottles left by our White Sands residents. The money raised is used to fund the many White Sands social functions held throughout the year and, in consultation with the Summer Village of White Sands, contribute to the betterment of the community such as the management of the flower beds, or the purchase of beach benches and picnic tables for example. The Hall Society holds resident quarterly meetings including a June annual meeting at which its directors are elected. Every property owner in the
